National Health Systems Resource Centre (NHSRC) is a technical support institution under the National Health Mission (NHM), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. NHSRC works closely with the MoHFW and the States for Health Systems strengthening and supporting implementation of other interventions under the NHM. Work at the NHSRC is organised around eight (8) divisions, namely– Community Processes & Comprehensive Primary Care, Healthcare Financing, Healthcare Technology, Human Resources for Health, Information Technology, Knowledge Management Division, Public Health Administration and Quality & Patient Safety.

The Position reports to the Principal Team Lead- Technical NHSRC. This Position requires a strong moral and ethical code of conduct with essence of integrity, confidentiality while undertaking the responsibility.

Roles & Responsibilities

1. Develop responsive web and PWA applications for public health program users.
2. Build reusable Angular components and front-end modules.
3. Create user-friendly interfaces for care delivery, program operations, and reporting workflows.
4. Integrate front-end applications with backend APIs.
5. Collaborate with product, design, backend, QA, and implementation teams.
6. 8–10 years of front-end development experience.
7. Strong hands-on experience with Angular.
8. Good knowledge of TypeScript, HTML5, CSS3, and JavaScript.
9. Experience building responsive web applications.
10. Experience with REST API integration.
11. Understanding of PWA concepts such as service workers, caching, and offline usage.
12. Experience with public health, healthcare, or government program platforms.
13. Experience with Angular Material or similar UI frameworks.
14. Knowledge of accessibility and usability best practices.
15. Exposure to dashboards, reporting interfaces, or data-heavy web applications.
