

Terms of Reference
Short Term Consultant – Tribal Health Cell, NHSRC

National Health Systems Resource Centre (NHSRC) has been set up under the National Health Mission (NHM) as an autonomous registered society, to channelize technical assistance and capacity building support to the states for strengthening the public health system. The NHSRC is also mandated to contribute to health policy / programme design and evaluation.

NHSRC intends to engage Consultants for Tribal Health programmes purely on a contractual basis. The candidate should have the capacity and expertise on Statistics, documentation and experience of understanding rural health issues and policy matters, liaise with government officials at centre and state level, accomplish the assignments within time and obtain information from all divisions in the ministry of health and family welfare. Ensure timely review of the programmes to provide an update on a periodic basis on the progress. The position offers an opportunity to participate in the process of strengthening health care delivery systems in tribal and difficult to reach areas and enabling positive health outcomes, learn from district and sub district implementation, undertake knowledge translation, and enable realization of the vision of universal health coverage.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- To review and report matters related to tribal health on timely manner.
- To coordinate and obtain feedback and inputs from various programme divisions of the ministry and provide analytical reports on programmes concerning tribal health.
- Document State and district level innovations.
- Undertake analytical documentation to inform required changes in policy, program planning and implementation.
- Contribute to development of specific technical and policy briefs, reports, case studies, monitoring checklists/protocols etc.
- Support in undertaking operational research and impact assessments for improving interventions in tribal health programmes.
- Undertake such other assignments, which may be assigned from time to time by the immediate supervisor.

Qualification & Experience:

i) Essential:

- Medical/Dental/Health Science/ Political Science Graduate with Post Graduate qualification in Community Medicine/Public Health/Health Systems Research/Epidemiology / Health Policy & Planning.
- Have at least 01 year of post-qualification experience in implementation of health programmes, understanding of tribal and rural health issues.
- Experience in documentation, data analysis, report writing and presentation.
- Coordination skills to work with States and various divisions within the ministry of health and family welfare.
- Excellent analytical skills, communication and presentation skills, and interpersonal abilities.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills in English.
- Good knowledge and experience of IT applications.

ii) Desirable:

- Working knowledge of Hindi / other major regional language
- Demonstrated ability to work in a multi-disciplinary team environment.
- Demonstrated experience in working with Government and coordination with NGOs led health programmes in tribal areas, Primary Health Care / State level public health programmes / Policy Formulation.

Age Limit: Up to 40 Years (as on the date of receiving the application)

Work Location: The position is New Delhi based with travel to different states and districts

Remuneration Range: Between Rs. 60,000/- to Rs. 1,20,000/-
